ACADEMIC ADVISOR RESUME

Academic advisors are responsible for making sure that students maintain high grades and meet the goals and expectations that are laid out for them. They may also be expected to provide some degree of postsecondary guidance for students who need it. This position typically requires a bachelor's degree in education, behavioral sciences, or a related field.

An academic advisor resume should emphasize your knowledge of social and psychological pressures that adolescents face as well as any experience you have in providing guidance for a post-academic career. Good communication skills and the ability to respond well in pressure situations are also desirable. Three academic advisor resume format options are provided below, with each one targeted at a different level of experience to show how varied the candidate pool of this job field can be.

Entry-Level Resume

This field can be a difficult one to break into, but a well-crafted resume can land you a job as an academic advisor even if you have no prior experience in the position. As you can see from the academic advisor resume example provided here, it is best to focus on your positive professional qualities such as your ability to communicate and advise others regarding social pressures. Noting any recent education that applies to this field is also very helpful.
