

NURSE PRACTITIONER RESUME

Nurse practitioners fill a key role in patient care and help assist healthcare teams for individuals with specialized needs. This position usually requires a master's degree and specific licensure, while some candidates pursue a doctoral degree as well. Individuals in this position need to be able to react well in high-pressure situations, handle many tasks at once, and always keep the needs of their patients in mind above all else.

Your nurse practitioner resume should include a section devoted to your education, with the specific certifications and relevant educational experiences highlighted. You will also want to include as much work experience as possible, even if that experience involves internships or volunteer work. Three nurse practitioner resume format options are presented below, and each one is tailored toward a different level of experience for your reference.

Entry-Level Resume

Somebody who is just beginning a career as a nurse practitioner should still possess a good number of skills and experiences that are relative to this position, since obtaining certification requires a lot of hands-on learning. The nurse practitioner resume example provided below presents Julia Little, a candidate who is just out of graduate school and who references her college experience and internship as a building block for her career.
