Such aspects include adequate educational background and/or training, as well as experience working in facilities that require installment, maintenance and repair. Also highlight your specific expertise: it could be with circuit and wiring diagrams, switchboard designs, hydraulic systems, or HV / MV & LV maintenance. Normally, employers would prefer an applicant who finished an Electronic Engineering degree or other related courses.
